Accelerate your growth as an emerging global leader with a transformative week-long program that will equip you to be a more effective and ethical changemaker. The Abshire-Inamori Leadership Academy at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) designs the AILA International Fellowship to give participants the tools and agile mindset to enact innovative solutions to critical challenges. Through five days of intensive seminars, simulations, and experiential learning, AILA International Fellows gain a new set of skills to help them navigate complex global dynamics and the moral judgments they must make as leaders.

AILA INTERNATIONAL FELLOWS

The AIF program brings together a diverse cohort of mid-career professionals in the corporate, nonprofit, military, and government arenas from across the U.S. and around the globe. Each year, a select group of approximately 24 Fellows leverage their diversity to address the intellectual, ethical, cultural, and policy questions that are central to effective leadership in today's world. Each Fellow amplifies their professional skills and leadership potential in a collaborative, cross-sector, and multicultural atmosphere.

Since 2003, CSIS has welcomed over 250 AILA International Fellows from 62 countries, creating a vibrant and supportive network of alumni who continue to engage with one another on contemporary issues and leadership strategies.

A DYNAMIC CURRICULUM

CSIS has crafted an approach to global leadership that is both creative and pragmatic, based on expertise but always open to new ideas. We believe that the most effective real-world solutions must be grounded in a deep understanding of the challenges and changes in global geopolitics and economics as well as in a principled approach to addressing complex issues. During the five-day program, you and your fellow participants will be immersed in a series of progressive challenges that weave together four essential components:

GLOBAL CHALLENGES

Engage in probing, off-the-record discussions with CSIS's world-class experts and practitioners to expand your knowledge about pressing issues; deepen your ability to analyze the significance of social, economic, and political forces; and recognize connections across issue areas.

ETHICS

Expand your perspective on ethics and leadership through seminar discussions with colleagues from around the world and use guided reflections to calibrate your own moral compass for ethical decision-making and vision. You'll bring these new insights into play in simulation exercises to construct viable and ethical solutions to current global challenges.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Become a more powerful changemaker by strengthening the links between your most deeply-held values and your leadership vision through deliberate reflection and coaching support. Deepen your insights into your leadership strengths and potential and learn to facilitate more productive workplace culture and relationships through experiential team exercises. Build strategic negotiation skills by finding opportunities to exercise lateral leadership.

COMMUNICATION

Have a greater impact by communicating your ideas efficiently, effectively, and memorably. You'll work with an executive communication coach to design a compelling message and deliver it with poise. You will also develop new skills in cross-cultural and nonverbal communication.
