PROGRAM DESIGN

Fellows begin the Women's Global Leadership Program with an intensive week-long retreat at CSIS headquarters in Washington, D.C., in February. In May and November, the cohort reconvenes at CSIS for two days of rigorous seminars and workshops. Participants also engage with one another and CSIS experts in monthly videoconferences and interactive online programming.

Fellows refine their leadership and communication through experiential workshops, with a unique focus on women in senior positions:

- ▶ Persuade with storytelling savvy, on camera or live.
- ▶ Build solutions through collaboration and creative negotiation.
- ▶ Craft fulfilling team and organizational culture.
- ▶ Focus with personalized leadership coaching.

WGLP Fellows forge close connections with other participants, speakers, and coaches and join an expansive network of over 200 alumnae.



PARTICIPANTS

CSIS accepts 24 nominees to participate in each Women's Global Leadership Program cohort. Successful nominees will generally have:

- ▶ At least 15 years of experience.
- ▶ The potential to serve in senior executive positions in the corporate, nonprofit, or public spheres.
- ▶ Demonstrated experience and commitment to advancing women's leadership.

Nominees may be drawn from anywhere within their organization's structure, including business units, government relations teams, international divisions, and corporate strategy offices. While designed for women leaders (and likely most beneficial to those who identify as such), the program is open to all who otherwise fulfill the admissions criteria.

TUITION

Tuition for the Women's Global Leadership Program is \$25,000. CSIS offers a reduced tuition rate for government and nonprofit organizations. Fellows are responsible for all program-related travel and lodging.
