



Trend in Number of HEWs Deployed






Trend in number of Health Posts Constructed


Trend in the Number of Facilities Providing HCT, PMTCT and ART Services



Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission of HIV (PMTCT)

- 75,420 HIV infected pregnant mothers and 14,148 HIV infected births within a year
- Plan for 2000 EFY 15,000 pregnant women
- 4478 mothers received ARVs =5.9% of those eligible and 30% of the plan
- 25% of infected infants received PMTCT prophylaxis

Trend in Number of PLHA who Accessed Chronic HIV Care and ART



Trend in Number of Insecticide-Treated Nets (ITNs) Distributed




Trend of Malaria Cases and Deaths (Ethiopia, January 2005 – May 2008)











Trends in TB Case Detection, Treatment Success and Cure Rates 1995-2000.






Trend in Antenatal Care, Supervised Delivery and Postnatal Care Coverage






Trends in DPT3/Pentavalent, Measles Immunization and Full Immunization Coverage








