Purpose: To continue to assist Poland's planning and modernization of its defense industrial base through a deepening of Polish-American industry partnership.

Participation: The Polish delegation will be led by His Excellency Professor Michal Kleiber, Minister of Science, His Excellency Jerzy Jaskiernia, Chairman, Foreign Affairs Committee, Sejm and Mr. Krzysztof Krystowski, Deputy Minister of Economy. The delegation will include 37 Polish leaders and experts from government and business, and will be joined by 35 American government and business leaders.

Approach: The conference will be organized around the objectives of industry cooperation, defense transformation tasks and the security mission for homeland security. The conference will be conducted in the English language. A report of actions agreed to during the conference will be prepared. This conference and the working group itself are a joint effort of CSIS's Action Commission program and the Institute for Strategic Issues.

Related Conference: A second conference will be held on May 21 also at CSIS to advocate specific practices, understandings and opportunities for increased Polish-American cooperation in research and development.
