The Gas on Green Dilemma

- Global gas demand to grow, especially in a carbon constrained world; 40% cleaner than coal but not emission free
- To some, increased reliance on gas means perpetuating a less desirable (albeit cleaner) fossil fuel system
- In the near term, however, there are no simply scalable, emission free alternatives that don't come with challenges of their own
- With demand growth, there's room for all alternatives, BUT in a low demand case, with low priced gas, some cleaner alternatives can begin to get "crowded out" of the mix
